My name is Father P.J. Brandimarti.

It is a great honor to begin serving you as your parish administrator, beginning August 1st, here in our community of Church of the Ascension.

I am a native of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, where I grew up with my parents, Paul and Joan, and my sister Elena. My brother, Gian Paul, passed away before I was born. I worked in retail and retail management for Circuit City in Pittsburgh. I moved to Columbus in 2008 to accept a position working for Sony Electronics. I then took a job in 2010 with Motorola Mobility as the market development manager for Central Ohio. After coming back to the practice of the faith, I discerned a call to the priesthood and entered seminary at the Pontifical College Josephinum in 2012. I graduated with my bachelor's and master's degrees from there, and was ordained a priest by Bishop Robert Brennan on May 25, 2019. I served as Parochial Vicar of St. Paul the Apostle in Westerville and St. Luke and St. Vincent de Paul churches in Knox County. I was named a Knight of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulcher in 2022, and I received my Master of Business Administration from Bowling Green State University in 2023.

I am deeply honored also to serve as the only Catholic chaplain in the Ohio Army National Guard. I was commissioned a first lieutenant and completed chaplain's basic training at Fort Jackson, South Carolina this year. I continue to serve our soldiers one weekend a month and two weeks a year as a chaplain.

In my spare time, I love watching sports. I am a devoted Pittsburgh Steelers, Pittsburgh Penguins and Columbus Blue Jackets fan. I love pretty much all music, but Gregorian Chant and early 2000s pop punk are my favorite genres. I am a horrible golfer, and I love watching movies, especially Star Trek and Star Wars.

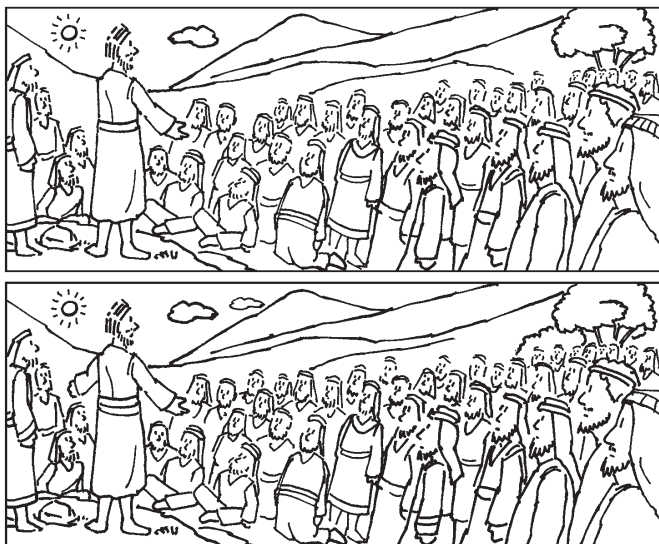

HUNGRY

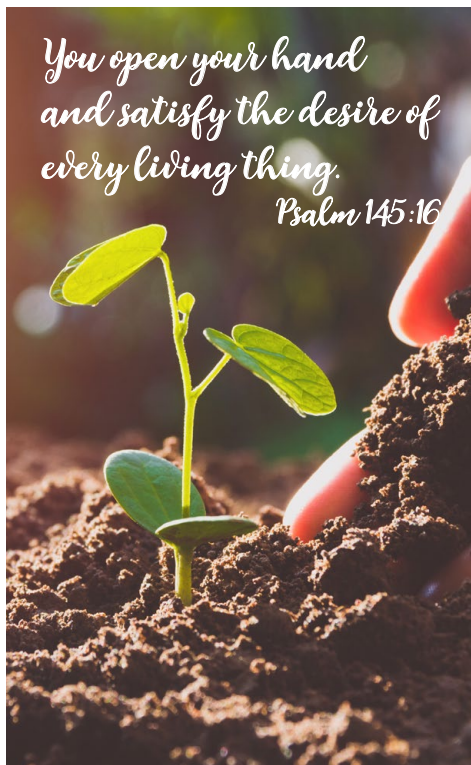
Reflection on 2 Kings 4:42-44

There is a story told about Mohandas Gandhi, a person who certainly knew the aching hearts of hungry millions. When asked once about Christ's followers and the meal that united them, he said: "I have finally figured out the meaning of the Eucharist. How else could God come to a hungry world except in food and drink?"

John's narrative of the feeding of the crowd is a foreshadowing of the gift of the Eucharist. We discover that with Jesus, hunger has a way of getting satisfied, because bread has a way of getting multiplied. We are hungry for so much – real and lasting peace, respect and dignity, good health, intimacy, the realization of ideals and dreams, and so much more.

At every Eucharist, we become more deeply the gift of the Real Presence of Jesus that we receive in the form of bread and wine. We are the gift to each other; we feed each other's hungers. We become like the boy who had the five barley loaves and two fish that day – we offer all that we have and all that we are to feed the crowd. Jesus takes us, blesses us, breaks us open, and distributes us. And God's love is multiplied!

SAINT IGNATIUS OF LOYOLA

Saint of the Day: July 31

Patron Saint of: All Spiritual Retreats

The founder of the Jesuits was on his way to military fame and fortune when a cannonball shattered his leg. During his convalescence, Ignatius whiled away the time reading about the life of Christ and lives of the saints. His conscience was deeply touched, and a long, painful turning to Christ began. Having seen the Mother of God in a vision, he made a pilgrimage to her shrine at Montserrat near Barcelona. He remained for almost a year at nearby Manresa, sometimes with the Dominicans, sometimes in a pauper's hospice, often in a cave in the hills praying.

It was during this year of conversion that Ignatius began to write down material that later became his greatest work, the *Spiritual Exercises*.

In 1534, at the age of 43, he and six others – one of whom was Saint Francis Xavier – vowed to live in poverty and chastity and to go to the Holy Land. If this became impossible, they vowed to offer themselves to the apostolic service of the pope. The latter became the only choice. Four years later Ignatius made the association permanent. The new Society of Jesus was approved by Pope Paul III, and Ignatius was elected to serve as the first general.

Ignatius was a true mystic. He centered his spiritual life on the essential foundations of Christianity – the Trinity, Christ, the Eucharist. His spirituality is expressed in the Jesuit motto, *Ad maiorem Dei gloriam* – "for the greater glory of God." In his concept, obedience was to be the prominent virtue, to assure the effectiveness and mobility of his men. All activity was to be guided by a true love of the Church and unconditional obedience to the Holy Father, for which reason all professed members took a fourth vow to go wherever the pope should send them for the salvation of souls.
